Dashrath Manjhi, also known as the "Mountain Man" was a laborer in Gehlaur village in Bihar, India. He gained wide spread recognition for a remarkable feat he accomplished during the early 1960s. Manjhi single-handedly carved a path through a mountain using just a hammer and chisel. Dashrath Manjhi's incredible achievement was eventually recognized by the government and the public. He passed away in 2007, but his legacy lives on as a testament to the power of determination and the impact one individual can have on a community. The story of Dashrath Manjhi has been the subject of documentaries, books and even a Bollywood film titled "Manjhi: The Mountain Man" released in 2015.

## *Think Green, Drive Clean*


